




FIGURE 7: **D* - Court House**




FIGURE 8: E* - Union Bank




FIGURE 9: F* - Custom House, Exchange, &c.




FIGURE 11: H* - Univ. of Maryland





FIGURE 12: I* - Alms House




FIGURE 19: E - Christ Church




FIGURE 20: F - Germn. Luthn. Ch.




FIGURE 23: I - Eutaw Meeting




FIGURE 24: K - Western Fountain




FIGURE 25: L - Centre Fountain


FIGURE 27: N - First Indep. Ch. Received by the Unitarian Son




FIGURE 28: O German Ref. Ch. Lud Herring Arch


FIGURE 29: P - Evangl Ref. Ch. med Congregation, ope J. Small Sen! Arch!


FIGURE 30: **Q - Assoc. Ref. Ch.** Miragani Built dy Street opend 1815. cost 50,000 Rob. Watts Arch


















FIGURE 41: View of the City of Baltimore taken from the Observatory in 1822





FIGURE 44: First Baptist Church, Robert Mills, Architect

Figure 45: Detail from *Plan of the City of Baltimore...*Jail, Robert Cary Long, Sr., Architect





Figure 46: Virginia Penetentiary, circa 1797, B. H. Latrobe, Architect




FIGURE 48: Building Vignettes (Miscellaneous), from F. Klemm's Map of Baltimore ...


